Who are we?

JNCC is the public body that advises the UK Government and devolved administrations on UK-wide and international nature conservation.

Natural England are the government's adviser for the natural environment in England.

JNCC and Natural England are working alongside Defra to designate Highly Protected Marine Areas (HPMAs) in Secretary of State waters.

What are we collecting and using your information for?

The legal basis for this is 'public task' due to our joint responsibility to support Defra in designating HPMAs. As part of the third-party proposal process for HPMAs, we are collecting contact details for the lead contact for each HPMa proposal. The information we are collecting is the name, postal address, email address and phone number for the lead contact. This information will allow us to contact each proposer to discuss the proposal in more detail and provide feedback.

Where are we storing your information and will we share it?

We will store the information you provide in Official Sensitive folders which can only be accessed by permitted staff. The information will be retained until 14 January 2023. As part of our joint responsibility, we will share this data with Defra in order to support their work in designating HPMAs.

Your rights and our contact details

You are entitled to access any of your personal data which we hold. If you wish for us to send you a copy, please contact dataprotection@jncc.gov.uk with as much detail as possible on the information you would like us to provide and we will respond within one month.

You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data. You also have the right to request that we restrict or stop processing, rectify or delete your personal data.
